The LWVUS Board has recommended a national concurrence with a "Voter Representation / Electoral Systems" (i.e. Voting

Methods) at its 2020 convention. LWVUS is lacking a Voting Methods program position, and we may finally be able to fill this void!

The proposed concurrence has the following position-in-brief:

Support electoral systems at each level of government that encourage participation, are verifiable and auditable and enhance representation for all voters.
